

## Why a Health IT Accelerator?

- Most capital efficient way to stir innovation and accelerate the launch of high-quality, innovative healthcare IT companies
- Portfolio to drive significant investment returns through a diversity of companies from some of the brightest young minds in the country
- Platform for fostering and building a community around innovation

## Why a Health IT Accelerator?

- Platform for key participants in the healthcare ecosystem to work together collaboratively including providers, payors, manufacturers (e.g. pharma) and distributors (e.g. retail)

- Helps to build the Baltimore region as a healthcare IT startup community
- Only national accelerator with specific healthcare expertise and proven with the launch of Dreamlt Health in Philadelphia with Penn Medicine (UPHS) and IBC




- 4-month crucible


